To the President of the Council.

Your Excellency,

With reference to my letter of the 11th instant,
I have the honour to inform you that, in execution of your
recommendation of March 9th, the Polish authorities have handed
over to the Lithuanian authorities the eight frontier-guards
who were taken prisoners at the time of the incident in the
forest of Podhajec. They were set at liberty at Podbledzie on
the 16th instant at 10 p.m. A procès-verbal was drawn up and
signed on the spot by the representatives of the Polish and
Lithuanian authorities.
