JURISDICTION OF DANZIG COURTS IN ACTIONS BROUGHT
BY DANZIG RAILWAY OFFICIALS AGAINST THE POLISH
RAILWAY ADMINISTRATION.⁽¹⁾

Note by the Secretary-General.

The Secretary-General has the honour to inform the Members of the Council that the High Commissioner of the League of Nations in Danzig has just communicated to him the following documents, concerning the question of the jurisdiction of Danzig Courts in actions brought by Danzig Railway Officials against the Polish Railway Administration:

- (1) Advisory Opinion by Professor Louis Le Fur, of the Legal Faculty, Paris, submitted by the Polish Government.
- (2) Note dated September 10th, 1927, containing the observations of the Danzig Senate on the Polish Note of August 17th, 1927 (see document C.415.1927.I) and on the Advisory Opinion of Professor Caviglieri (See document C.429.1927.I.).
