TRAFFIC IN OPIUM AND OTHER DANGEROUS DRUGS.

Commission of Enquiry into the control of Opium-smoking
in the Far East.

Letter from the British Government regarding a
further contribution towards the expenses of
the enquiry promised by the Siamese Government.

The Secretary-General.

Sir,

I am directed by Secretary Sir Austen Chamberlain
to state, for the information of the members of the Council
of the League of Nations, that the Siamese Government have
agreed to guarantee, in addition to the sum of ten thousand
Swiss francs already promised, a further sum of four thousand
Swiss francs as a contribution towards the expenses of the
proposed Commission of Enquiry.

2. Funds are therefore now forthcoming to meet the
whole of the estimated cost of the enquiry, namely two
hundred and fifty thousand francs.
