TRAFFIC IN OPIUM AND OTHER DANGEROUS DRUGS

ORDER No.148 RELATING TO THE INCLUSION OF DOLANTIN IN
TABLES "A" AND "B" OF THE GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS CONCERNING
THE USE OF AND TRADE IN NARCOTIC DRUGS, ISSUED ON
MARCH 9th, 1939.

In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 1931 for limiting the Manufacture and regulating the Distribution of narcotic drugs, the Acting Secretary-General has the honour to communicate herewith to the Parties to the Convention the text of the above-mentioned order. This text is communicated also to other States.

NATIONAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT.

Order No.148.

The Director-General of the National Health Department, in conformity with the proposal made by the National Drug Control Committee, and in accordance with the provisions of Article 1, paragraphs 2 and 3, of Legislative Decree No.891, dated November 25th, 1938,

Resolves :

To amend the General Instructions concerning the Use of and Trade in Narcotic Drugs, issued on March 9th, 1939, so as to include in table "A", group 1, the hydrochloride of 1-methyl-4-phenyl-piperidine-4-carbonic-acid-ethyl-ester, and in Table "B", as containing that substance, the pharmaceutical speciality known as Bayer's Dolantin (ampoules, tablets, and drops), the doses referred to in item 3, section b, of the above-mentioned Instructions being as follows: 3 ampoules, 10 tablets or 5 cubic centimetres of the form in solution for use as drops.
