TRAFFIC IN OPIUM AND OTHER DANGEROUS DRUGS.

COMPOSITION OF THE SUPERVISORY BODY CREATED UNDER ARTICLE 5
OF THE CONVENTION OF JULY 13th, 1931, FOR LIMITING THE
MANUFACTURE AND REGULATING THE DISTRIBUTION OF NARCOTIC DRUGS.
