COMMUNICATION FROM THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF COSTA RICA
IN REGARD TO ITS MEMBERSHIP OF THE LEAGUE.

Note by the Secretary-General.

The Secretary-General has the honour to circulate to the Members of the League, a letter dated December 24th, 1924, from His Excellency Monsieur Manuel de Peralta, Minister of Costa Rica at Paris.

Translation.

Sir,

I have the honour to forward to your Excellency a cheque of the Banco de Costa Rica, drawn on the "Irving Bank Colombia Trust Company of New York", and endorsed to yourself by me, for eighteen thousand six hundred and sixty-seven dollars eighty-seven cents (\$18,667.87) in payment of the contribution due from the Republic of Costa Rica as a member of the League of Nations, in respect of the years 1921-1922, 1923 and 1924.

I should be much obliged if you would have a triplicate receipt for this sum sent to me, together with a statement of the present situation of the account of the Republic of Costa Rica with the League of Nations.

If there should be any balance in favour of my Government, I should be obliged if you would credit it to the contribution due for the year 1925.

I am instructed by my Government to notify your Excellency, in conformity with Article 1 of the Covenant of the League of Nations, that the Republic of Costa Rica withdraws from the League of Nations. I request your Excellency to take cognizance of this notification, which will have effect as from January 1st, 1925, so that Costa Rica will finally cease to be a member of the League on January 1st, 1927.

I shall be greatly obliged if your Excellency would kindly acknowledge receipt of this letter.
