COMMUNICATION FROM THE GOVERNMENT OF NEW ZEALAND.*

London, March 1st, 1937.

To the Secretary-General.

I have the honour to inform you that, acting under instructions received from the Prime Minister of New Zealand by telegram dated the 19th February, the Egyptian Government was informed that His Majesty's Government in New Zealand would welcome the admission of Egypt to the League of Nations, and invited the Egyptian Government to apply for admission.
