In accordance with Article 21 of the Convention of 1931 for limiting the Manufacture and regulating the Distribution of Narcotic Drugs, the Acting Secretary-General has the honour to communicate the above-mentioned report to the parties to the Convention. A. GENERAL

V. Illicit Traffic.<sup>(1)</sup>

"3 - During the year 316 persons were prosecuted for illegal possession of narcotic drugs, of whom 153 were convicted, 27 acquitted, 136 awaiting trial. Penalties imposed were fines ranging from LP.1 to LP.200 and terms of imprisonment which ranged from one to 18 months.

"5 - The total seizures of narcotic drugs during the year were 1766 kg. 788 gr. of opium, 3540 kg. 504 gr. of hashish and 16 grammes of cocaine".
