TELEGRAM FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE PAN-
AMERICAN CONFERENCE FOR THE CONSOLIDATION OF PEACE
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS.

(Translation)

Buenos-Aires, December 21st, 1936.

I have the honour to inform you that the Pan-American Conference for the Consolidation of Peace, at present in session at Buenos-Aires under my presidency, to-day unanimously approved in plenary session a resolution to the effect that the Conference's decisions should be formally communicated to two great institutions which, imbued with the highest idealism, co-operate with great authority with all those who work with good will to secure the reign of peace on earth, namely, the Catholic Church in the person of its visible head, the Sovereign Pontiff and Spiritual Father of the immense majority of the inhabitants of nearly all the States of America, who is an apostle of peace, and the League of Nations, which, like the present Conference, has been set up for the welfare of humanity as a result of an American initiative. Pending the transmission of the text of the decisions in question, I have the honour to be, etc.
