INTRODUCTORY REMARKS

This report is issued in accordance with the requirement of paragraph 9 of the Assembly resolution for the dissolution of the League, dated April 18th, 1946, that, after the transfer of the League's material assets, the Board of Liquidation shall make quarterly interim reports on the progress of its work.

The Board's First Interim Report,¹ issued on September 1st, 1946, gave an account of the action taken for the transfer of the material assets effected on August 1st last and indicated the stage then reached in the settlement of the other problems facing the Board.

The present report describes briefly the progress made in the work of liquidation during the interval since the publication of the First Report.

CHAPTER 2

TRANSFERS PENDING AS AT NOVEMBER 30TH, 1946

I. ASSETS

A. *Transfers to the United Nations awaiting completion.*

(a) *Archives.*

As was stated in the First Interim Report, the ownership of the archives passed to the United Nations on August 1st, 1946, but certain practical questions connected with their disposal have yet to be decided after the autumn 1946 General Assembly of the United Nations.

(b) *Assets the valuation of which is still pending (Buildings, Publications).*

Discussions are continuing for the final valuation of certain assets reserved under the "Common Plan" (see First Interim Report, Annex 1, Appendix, Schedule, footnotes 4 and 5, page 13).

(c) *Movable Assets of the Paris and New Delhi Branch Offices, and of the International Institute of Intellectual Co-operation.*

The ownership of these assets was transferred to the United Nations on August 1st, 1946; discussions are continuing on certain matters connected with their ultimate disposal.

(d) *Extra-budgetary Funds.*¹

Discussions for the disposal of these funds are making progress.

(e) *Library Endowment Fund.*²

The discussions with the United Nations concerning the conditions for the transfer of this fund are continuing.

(f) *Assets of the Far-Eastern Bureau, Singapore.*

The ownership of these assets was transferred to the United Nations on August 1st, 1946. Information has been received that part of the Bureau's archives, library and office equipment has survived the war, but that none of the furniture remains. A list of the surviving archives and books and an inventory of the equipment have been requested.

B. *Transfers to the International Labour Organisation.*

Staff Pensions Fund and Judges' Pensions Fund.

The International Labour Organisation has agreed in principle to the transfer of the Staff and Judges' Pensions Funds on the understanding that appropriate financial provision will be made prior to actual transfer. The financial position of these two funds is now under examination by the Liquidation Board, which will take into consideration the reports recently received from the Consulting Actuary. When the Liquidation Board has concluded this examination, it will make whatever financial provision for the funds it considers necessary. The Board is informed that, when the International Labour Organisation has received this information, the Governing Body will then be in a position to decide finally on accepting the transfer of the Funds at its next meeting in March. Pending the final decision, the International Labour Organisation has provided in the 1947 budget the necessary credits for the 1947 contributions to the Staff Pensions Fund administrative expenses and the estimated 1947 interest shortfall.

II. ACTIVITIES

1. *High Commissioner for Refugees.*

The League's connection with the current work of the High Commissioner for Refugees will be terminated not later than the end of 1946.³

2. *Far-Eastern Epidemiological Intelligence Service (Singapore Bureau).*

Discussions for the resumption of this activity by the United Nations, already agreed in principle, are continuing. Information has been received that the Health Intelligence Section of the British Government's Special Commissioner in South-East Asia has temporarily assumed certain epidemiological functions of the Eastern Bureau until the United Nations can make arrangements for taking them over.

(a) *Secretariat Staff Situation.*

The above figures comprise all staff on the Secretariat pay-roll, including those engaged on the work of liquidation, both in Geneva and elsewhere.

Some of the officials appearing in the right-hand column have been seconded to the United Nations, which refunds their salaries to the League. The right-hand column also includes certain officials who will ultimately be transferred to the International Labour Office.

(b) *Administrative Tribunal.*

The Administrative Tribunal is arranging to hold a session in February 1947 to hear three cases in respect of the Secretariat and five in respect of the International Institute of Intellectual Co-operation.

CHAPTER 8

FINANCIAL QUESTIONS

(a) *Liquidation Expenses for 1947.*

Expenditure in connection with the liquidation of the League for the first three months of 1947 is estimated at Swiss francs 200,100, for which provision has been made in accordance with paragraph 2 (6) of the Assembly resolution for the dissolution of the League, dated April 18th, 1946.¹

(b) *Audit of the 1946 Accounts.*

Arrangements have been made with the Auditor for the usual audit, at the earliest possible date in 1947, of the 1946 accounts of the Secretariat, the International Labour Organisation and the Permanent Court of International Justice. The Auditor's report on these accounts will be circulated to Governments in due course.

(c) *Contributions outstanding.*

A statement setting forth contributions outstanding as at November 30th, 1946, will be found in Annex 1. The Board is continuing negotiations with a view to the payment of these arrears.

(d) *Position of Contributions received as at November 30th, 1946.*

Annex 2 contains a detailed statement of contributions received or still due in respect of the current financial period, of consolidated contributions and arrears.

In presenting the list of States still indebted to the League in respect of contributions, special attention is drawn to paragraph 6 of the Assembly resolution of April 18th, 1946, on the dissolution of the League, which reads:

“ Nothing in this resolution shall relieve any Member or former Member of the League of Nations from any pecuniary liability incurred by it towards the League of Nations, whether under the Budget for 1946 or under previous Budgets or in virtue of agreements with the League of Nations or in any other manner whatsoever; but the Board may, where in its discretion it considers this course to be justifiable, make a composition with any debtor Government for a lesser sum than is due, on condition that such a sum or the agreed instalments thereof shall be paid as promptly as possible. The report provided for in paragraph 21 shall give particulars of the debts which have been collected in full, those in regard to which a composition or only a partial payment has been made and those, if any, towards which no payment has been made. If any amounts due in respect of the International Labour Organisation remain unpaid at the date of the completion of the liquidation, a report on the collection of such contributions shall be communicated by the Board to the International Labour Organisation and such amounts shall be recoverable by that Organisation.”

The Liquidation Board desires to observe that the present report may be its last Interim Report, in which case its next report will be its Final Report on the Liquidation. In pursuance of the above-quoted passage from the Assembly resolution, it will be the duty of the Board in that report, which will be circulated to the Governments of all States Members, to furnish the final list of States which have not discharged their obligations to the League, together with a statement of their indebtedness.

The Liquidation Board points out that the prompt payment of outstanding arrears is essential to the closing of the liquidation accounts, and to the assessment of the interests of States Members in the assets.

The Liquidation Board will be constrained, at an early date, to fix a dead-line for the receipt of contributions, and States Members remaining in debt to the League are accordingly urged to discharge their obligations as soon as possible.
